Behavior Contract

THE PURPOSE OF THIS CONTRACT IS TO DEFINE SOME OF THE BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS FOR THE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM. THE EXPECTATIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. No hurting others, physically or verbally (no name calling).
2. No inappropriate language.
3. No screaming or yelling indoors (unless playing a game that calls for such activity).
4. Keep your hands to yourself- respect other's personal space.
5. No leaving the room or area of activity without permission.
6. Stay within sight of TEMA staff indoors and outdoors.
7. No running in the room or hallways.
8. Stay in your seat while eating.
9. Use good manners while eating.
10. Clean up after yourself- snacks, toys, games, etc.
11. BASP materials are to be used appropriately.
12. Computers and electronic games are to be used appropriately and put away correctly. (internet may be used only with permission).
13. Generally, behavior policies, expectations, and procedures outlined in the Elementary School Parent-Student Handbook apply at TEMA.
14. Respect others.
15. Have Fun!

THE CONSEQUENCES FOR BREAKING THE ABOVE RULES ARE AS FOLLOWS;

The child will be given verbal reminders and redirected. If the behavior continues, subsequent warnings will be placed in writing. The written warning slip will be signed by the TEMA Head Instructor, the child, and the parent. After the third written warning, the parent will be called in for a conference with the Head Instructor, the child, and the parent. If another infraction occurs with this child, he/she will be suspended from the program for two weeks. The next incident will result in the dismissal from the program entirely.

The following actions may result in a student's immediate dismissal from the program:

1. Physical attack or assault of a staff member
2. Threat to a staff member or to a staff member's property
3. Possession of a weapon, ammunition, or look-alike weapon
4. Arson/bomb threat/false fire alarm

TEMA behavioral expectations published here are subject to such changes as may be needed to insure continued compliance with federal, provincial, or municipal regulations and are subject to review and alteration as becomes necessary for the routine operation of the After School Program. Not all expectations of behavior can be written and inserted here; however, students are expected to follow rules and not violate the rights of others. I have read and fully understand the above contract and its consequences.
